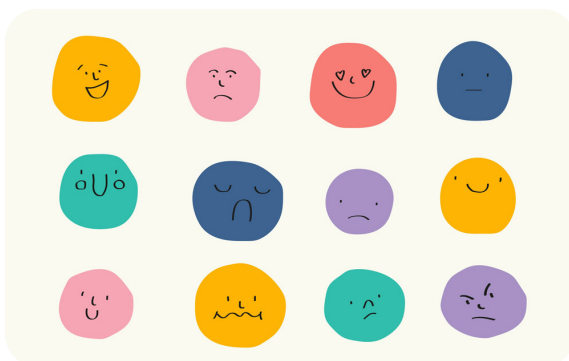
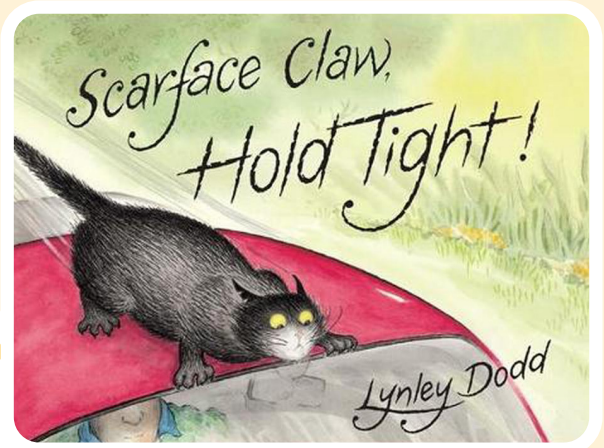


Scarface Claw Hold Tight!

Key themes:

- Empathy - responding to needs of others.
- Safety - importance of staying safe in scary spots.
- Community Awareness - looking out for others in the community.



Group activity/game:

Emotion charades:

Write down various emotions on cards (happy, sad, angry, surprised, etc.).

Have children take turns picking a card and acting out the emotion without speaking.

The other children guess the emotion and discuss when they might feel that way.

Conversation prompt:

Pose the following questions to the children to promote conversations around safety, helping others & other peoples feelings.

- What would you do if you saw a cat on a moving car?
- How do you think the people in the town felt when they saw the cat on the car?
- Why is it important for drivers to pay attention to what's happening around them?
- How can we help others who might be in danger or need assistance?

Crafting activity:

Story stones:

Have the kids come up with all the things they liked about the story and what it reminds them of. For example: their own pets, parents, police etc. Write these suggestions down on paper and cut them out into stone shapes. have the children take turns picking a stone and working collaboratively to build a new story.
